Pilots License guidelines

- 1) pilots are invited to take their test when considered competent and not at their own request
- 2) a written test has to be taken and passed, oral tests are not acceptable
- 3) after the sailing test has been taken, three or more questions should be asked concerning possible situations arising during racing which require avoiding action. These should be answered correctly
- 4) The written test must be passed before a sailing test is taken
- 5) the sailing test must be separate including a complete set of manoeuvres and not be part of any competition or general sailing.
- 6) A period of two months must elapse before application is made for upgrading to national events.
- 7) Applications must be made on the official BFSLYC form. Upgrade forms are issued with licenses and sent to pilots direct.
- 8) Completed test papers and sailing test results should be retained by the club for reference and inspection.
